1.	Pressure Ulcer (PU)	a. Refers to practices such as hand washing that reduce, remove, and control the spread of microorganisms.
2.	Stage 1 PU	b. Passage or transfer
3.	Stage 2 PU	c. An uninfected person who could get sick.
4.	Stage 3 PU	d. Not capable of causing infection or disease
5.	Stage 4 PU	e. Skin is broken to the epidermis (surface skin) or dermis (deeper skin)
6.	Venous Ulcers	f. Contagious.
7.	Direct Contact	g. Any body opening on an uninfected person that allows pathogens to enter.
8.	Indirect Contact	h. The membranes that line body cavities that open to the outside of the body, such as the linings of the mouth, nose, eyes, r
9.	Portal of Entry	i. Skin is unbroken, but inflamed
10.	Mucous Membranes	j. Injuries to skin and underlying tissue resulting from prolonged pressure on the skin.
11.	Susceptible Host	k. Capable of causing infection or disease.
12.	Transmission	l. A way of transmitting pathogens through touching the infected person or his or her secretions.
13.	Infection	m. Skin is broken and ulcer extends to muscle or bone
14.	Medical Asepsis	n. The state of being free of all microorganisms; also called sterile technique.
15.	Surgical Asepsis	o. Ulcer that form because of insufficient blood return from the leg.
16.	Pathogenic Mico	p. A way of transmitting pathogens from touching something contaminated by the infected person.
17.	Non- Pathogenic Micro	q. Skin is broken to the subcutaneous fat layer (deepest part of the skin)
